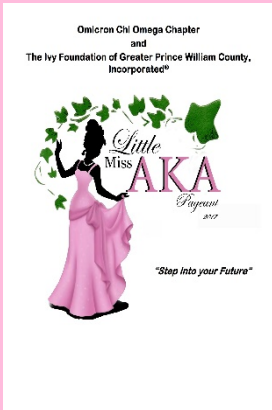

Color:

- Pastel Pink

Length:

- Little Miss Tea Rose - **Ages 9-12** - Formal Floor Length
- Little Miss Pink and Green - **Ages 13-17** - Formal Floor Length

Shoes:

- **Ages 5-8** - White socks with white shoes or Pink Socks with Pink Shoes
- **Ages 9-12** - Hosiery to complement dress and skin tone
- **Ages 13-17** - Hosiery to complement dress and skin tone

Jewelry:

- Single Strand White Pearls, Post or Clip-On Single Pearl Earrings

Pageant escort attire:

- Semi-Formal or Business Professional

Additional Details:
